### P 7698 Gatwick Northern Runway Project (DCO) - London Gatwick Consultation: Providing an option for an on-airport Wastewater Treatment Works facility

The Chairman explained that London Gatwick had opened a short consultation on a further potential change to its Northern Runway proposals, concerning an on-airport Wastewater Treatment Works facility to manage wastewater flows from the airport, if these could not be dealt with effectively by the water company (Thames Water). Additionally, a helpful briefing, held virtually, had been given by London Gatwick which he had attended. It was noted from the information provided that there were no significant impacts for Horley or other concerns at the present time. However, the Town Council would reserve the right to make further comment at a future stage, should the proposals change and the response was supported by the committee.
