Bridge deck works will take place between 9 December 2024 and 10 January 2025. During this time, the subway will be closed by the footbridge will remain open.

#### **High Street Public Realm:**

Final drawings are to be confirmed with an anticipated start in the first quarter of 2025. Additionally, discussions with local businesses and community groups in regard to access and traffic flow restrictions are to take place.

#### **Central Car Park:**

The planting of trees and shrubs took place between earlier in the month and EV charge points will be installed in the New Year.

#### Westvale Park Neighbourhood Hall

The hall is currently being constructed and premarket engagement will take place to receive expressions of interest from organisations and community groups interested in running the hall. ClIr Saunders remarked that running the hall might be of interest to the Town Council, subject to receipt of a formal business proposal and more information. This would allow the Council to assess the viability and make an informed decision on whether to proceed with such an initiative and submit an expression of interest.
